



Robyn's Tiny Angel Gowns

Thank you for your kind donation of knitting for Robyn's Tiny Angel Gowns. Each of our gown pack contains two tiny blankets - one for baby and one for the family to take home. For this reason, we would kindly ask that donations of blankets are made in pairs. Your first name will appear within the pack unless you would prefer to donate anonymously.

Yarn: Soft DK Baby Wool in Cream
(e.g. Style Craft Bambino DK in Clotted Cream no.7112)

Needles: 4mm

Gauge: The finished blanket should be a square, minimum 23cm x 23cm

A 100g ball of DK yarn should be enough to make three blankets. The blanket is worked by casting on three stitches, then increasing by one stitch each row until a total of 65. Three rows are then worked in garter stitch. Next, one stitch is decreased on each row until only three remain, which are cast off. The ends are sewn in.

Key: kfb: Knit into front and back of the same stitch to increase
k2tog: Knit two stitches together to decrease

Pattern: Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: k1, kfb, k1 [4 stitches]

Row 2: k1, kfb, knit to end [5 stitches]

Rows 3 – 62: k1, kfb, knit to end [65 stitches]

Rows 63 – 65: knit

Row 66: k1, k2tog, knit to end [64 stitches]

Rows 67 – 125: k1, k2tog, knit to end [3 stitches]

Cast off

Finish by neatly sewing in the ends
